






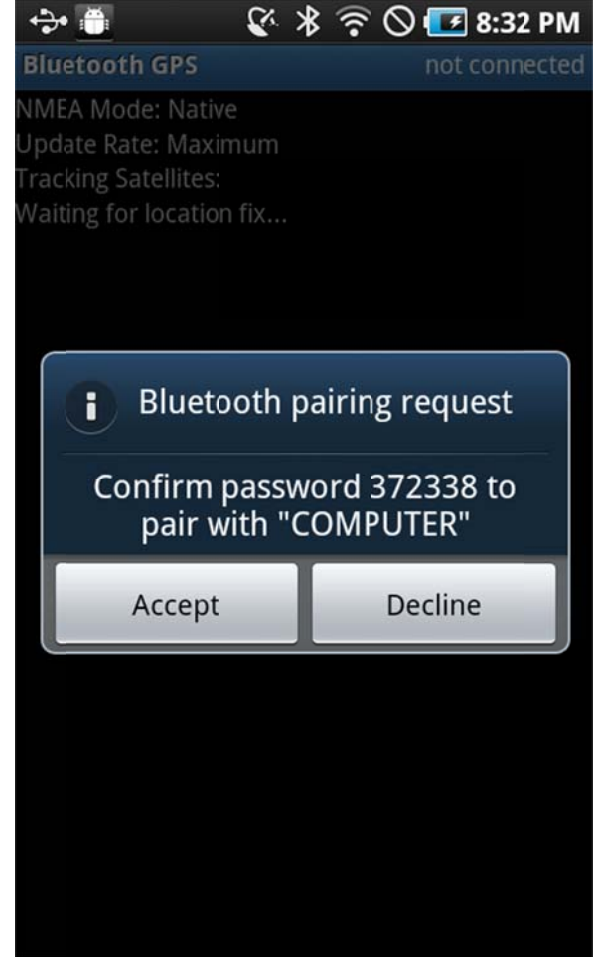
PAIRING YOUR ANDROID PHONE WITH YOUR PC FOR USAGE WITH INSSIDER (WINDOWS 7 GUIDE)

Step 6: Pairing with your PC

- Your phone should indicate that your computer is trying to pair with it.
- Touch ACCEPT
- Note that "COMPUTER" will be filled with the name of your actual computer.

**Step 7: Begin Pairing with your PC**

- Windows will finish the pairing process and let you know of the result.
- Click the CLOSE button.



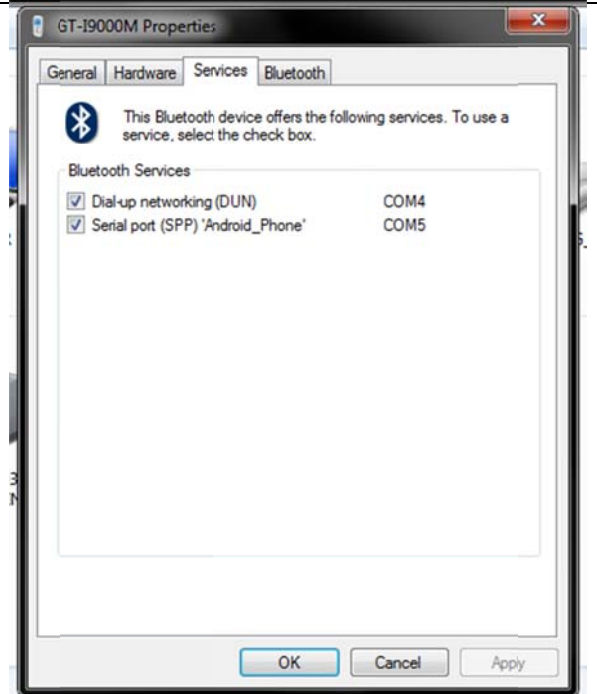
Step 8: Confirming the COM port number

- Look for your phone in the Device and Printer's list.
- Right click to display the context menu
- Left click on PROPERTIES



Step 9: Confirming the COM port number

- The properties window will appear for your phone.
- Click the SERVICES tab
- Look for "Serial port (SPP)" 'Android_Phone' or 'SPP Slave'
- Note the COM number to its right.
- In this example, COM5 is shown.



Step 10: Configuring inSSIDer

- Download and install inSSIDer
- Run inSSIDer
- Click FILE
- Click CONFIGURE GPS
